## Spring Term 1

### Ancient Egypt

#### English Class Text- "The Egyptian Cinderella" by Shirley Climo

We revisit the classic tale of 'Cinderella' with a twist. We will meet Rhodopis, who is an Egyptian servant, and we will be looking at the similarities and differences between the Egyptian version of the traditional story and the original version.

From the text, we gain inspiration to a character description. We will also be exploring a newspaper report called 'Tut in Murder Mystery' where we will be acting as detectives to figure out how Tutankhamun died. We will gain inspiration to write out own newspaper reports.

In grammar, we will be exploring plural possession and fronted subordinated clauses. The Year 4's will also be exploring capital letters for proper nouns.

#### PSHE- Keeping Myself Safe

This half term, we will be exploring our theme through role-play and guided discussions. We will be spotting risks that may happen in certain situations and we will discuss how we can deal with them.

#### History

We will be exploring when the Ancient Egypt era started and ended. We will be using timelines and using evidence to support what we know. We will explore artefacts and different sources, working on historical enquiry.
