Spring Term 2

Topic Theme: Café Europe (continued)

English Class Text- Sweet Pizza

We continue learning about life in Wales in the mining communities, over hundred years ago. In writing, we turn our attention to fiction writing. We will focus on writing descriptive writing, using a film clip stimulus. The children will write about a journey into a forest. We will also write our own short story, using one of Pie Corbett's short stories as a starting point. In grammar, we will focus on using expanded noun phrases, adverbs and verbs for effect. We will also work on advancing action through dialogue.

Rights and Respect

Pupils identify, discuss and write about a current wellbeing issue in the media. They look at biased reporting and learn to think critically about information. They consider what it means to be a discerning consumer and the influences that they are exposed to that might make them want to buy a product. They consider the differences between rights, responsibilities and duties and look at the work of voluntary, community and pressure groups.

Maths

Year 5: Perimeter and Area: We will work on finding the perimeter and area of shapes.

Decimals and Percentages: We will work with decimals up to 3 dp and look at equivalent fractions and decimals. We will order, compare and round fractions and begin to understand percentages.

Statistics: We will learn to interpret and draw line graphs and tables.

Year 6: Fractions, decimals and percentages: We will work on ordering fractions, decimals and percentages. We will also work on missing values and 2-step percentage problems

Area, perimeter and volume: We will work on finding the area of triangles and parallelograms along with finding the volume of cuboids.

Statistics: We will work on interpreting line graphs, bar charts and pie charts. We will draw bar charts and learn how to work out the mean of a set of data.

Science

We investigate forces, what they are, what they do and how we can measure them. We investigate air resistance, friction and water resistance. We investigate how to control and increase forces through the use of pulleys and levers.

Music

We prepare musical performances for our Easter service, combining instruments and voices. Pupils learn to play their part within a group performance controlling tempo and dynamic.

French

We explore the vocabulary of ordering food.

Computing

Pupils learn to compose using Garageband. Our focus is for children to know how to layer sounds and effects to create music

Design Technology

We research the recipes of our chosen country then plan, prepare and serve a three course meal for our guests in the style of that country. As we work, we learn about balanced diets and how environmental and social factors can affect diet.

PE

Pupils further develop their gymnastics skills, learn about effective teamwork and communication skills and apply these to outdoor adventurous activity group work.
