



Class 3 Curriculum Map (Cycle B)

Summer Term 2

Topic Theme: Coal Mining in Doncaster

English

We will continue studying the novel *Holes*. This is a book set in Texas about a young boy who is wrongly accused of a crime and sent to Juvenile Detention Centre. This will really get the children to develop a sense of justice and will encourage reflection on human rights. In writing, we will write informal letters along with diary entries. We will focus on using a range of sentence types and using vocabulary and grammar to affect the reader.

PSHE- Growing and Changing

Children will learn to understand the different feelings they may experience throughout a day. They will learn about safe and unsafe secrets. Children will also learn about how their bodies will change and the myths associated with puberty. Throughout this unit, children will also learn the word associated with the external sexual organs.

Maths

Year 5:

Negative numbers: We will learn about negative numbers and how they are used in real-life situations.

Converting Units: We will learn the different units for measurement and how we can convert them.

Volume: We will learn to understand volume and how it can be measured.

Year 6: Themed Problem Solving linked to projects, which will develop children's skills in all areas of mathematics.

History

We find out about coal mining in the neighbouring city of Doncaster. We learn about the timeline of mining and how politics affected the growth of this industry. We will have experts in to speak to the children, giving their first-hand accounts of how the strikes affected families.

Art

We will focus on 3D art, while learning about Yayoi Kusama. We will learn how shape, form and detail can be used to evoke feelings.

Geography

We will learn how to read 6 figure grid references.

Music

We will work controlling pulse and rhythm. We learn to identify different speeds of pulse and improvising rhythm patterns. We learn what subdivide means while keeping to a steady beat.

Design Technology

We will make our very own wooden photo frame to display a piece of writing or art we are proud of. We will learn that a 3d frame can be reinforced and strengthened.
