



# Class 3 Curriculum Map (Cycle A)

## Autumn Term 1

### Topic Theme: Seas, coasts and islands

#### English Class Novel: Room 13.

We read Room 13 as it links very closely to our fieldwork in Whitby. This book is set in Whitby, where a group of children go on a residential visit to Whitby and discover the delights of Room 13 in their hotel.

In Writing, we will focus on descriptive writing, letters and postcards. We will focus on really knowing all word classes and apply them precisely to our writing. We will learn the difference between formal and informal language and use commas for clarity.

#### PSHE – Me and My Relationships (Y6)

This half term we explore assertiveness, and cooperation in our relationships. In order to do this, we cultivate negotiation and compromise through activities and discussion. We discuss safe/unsafe touches and explain what appropriate and inappropriate touch is and give examples.

#### Science

We study materials in detail, comparing and sorting them by more complex properties and thinking how these properties allow us to separate them efficiently. We look at mixtures and solutions, consider how these can be separated and investigate the solubility of salt in water. Finally we look at irreversible changes in materials

#### Maths

Year 5:

Addition and Subtraction: We will focus on adding and subtracting numbers with more than 4 digits.
