



Class 3 Curriculum Map (Cycle A)

Autumn Term 2

Topic Theme: What a performance

English: Class Text- Street Child

We study this powerful text, which is about the mistreatment of humans in Victorian Workhouses. This text will evoke real emotion and engage children into powerful debates. In writing, we will create balanced arguments about workhouses, write in character and do some diary writing. We will focus on a range of Key Stage 2 punctuation, along with relative and subordinate clauses to add more precise detail.

PSHE – Valuing Differences (Y6)

This half term, we explore the differences there are in society and how it is important to value and respect this. We will also work on challenging gender stereotypes.

Maths

Year 5: Multiplication and Division: We learn about common multiples and factors, along with prime, square and cubed numbers. We will focus on multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 100.

Fractions: We will focus on equivalent fractions, improper fractions and mixed numbers. We will also compare and order fraction, as well as adding and subtracting.

Year 6: Fractions: We will work on simplifying and finding equivalent fractions. We will compare and order fractions, along with adding and subtracting mixed numbers. We will then move on to multiplying and dividing fractions and work on finding a fraction of an amount.

Converting measurements: We will look at converting metric and imperial measures.

Science

We develop our understanding of the human body by studying the circulation system, learning about the components of blood the function of the heart and the transport of fluids and nutrients around the body. We investigate the effects of exercise on pulse rate and learn how to maintain a healthy circulation system

History

We will develop our knowledge of the Victorian Time Period. We will focus on writing an explanation of cause and effect and examine the impact this time period had on society.

French

We explore the vocabulary of school.

Art

We focus on Lowry. Within this, we focus on sketching techniques, particularly perspective and lines.

Drama

We audition and rehearse for Pantocrime. Learning performance skills and how to sing and dance as a group and individuals to create an effective production.

PE

We work on our gymnastics skills focussing on balance and control. We practise passing and receiving skills to improve our game play.

RE- Exploring the Bible

Christianity. We look at why Christians celebrate Jesus' birth and research what is important to a Christian. Individually pupils consider rewrite before next sequence.

Computing

We work on Microsoft Word skills. We will learn how to manipulate and edit documents.
