Summer Term 2

Topic Theme: Macbeth

English

Class Text- Macbeth

This half-term, we will focus on Shakespeare's very famous Macbeth. The children will learn this story through drama and will then re-write this story in their own words. We will also explore crime scene reports throughout this unit. The children will explore the language of Shakespeare, along with focusing on advancing action through dialogue and manipulating sentence structures for effect.

PSHE: Growing and Changing

This unit explores how we grow up. We explore how qualities people have are not just 'looks'. We explore media manipulation and pressure to 'look good'. We also work on our sex education within this unit.

Art

We will explore the graffiti artist: Keith Haring. We explore paint and colour mixing and how colours and tones can affect the mood.

Maths

Year 5:

Negative numbers: We will learn about negative numbers and how they are used in real-life situations.

Converting Units: We will learn the different units for measurement and how we can convert them.

Volume: We will learn to understand volume and how it can be measured.

Year 6: Themed Problem Solving linked to projects, which will develop children's skills in all areas of mathematics.

Computing

We will continue to develop our knowledge of programming. Children will learn that simplified code can be used to make their programme more efficient. They will learn a programme can be made using multiple functions.

PE

We develop our athletics skills in preparation for sports day.

French

This half-term, we will focus on language linked to the weekend.

Music

We will focus on listening, memory and movement. We will explore how mood is created through movement and lyrics and listen to long and short pieces of music and identify features.
